1/Register:

In advance online and pick up your clue books and bracelets by Sunday October, 8th, @ The National Black Doll Museum, 288 North Main Street. Then just check in at the South Common by 11:30 am. (Recommended)

OR

Register onsite Monday, October 9th on the South Common..

2/Hunt!

The Hunt begins at Noon, sharp! Let the photos and riddle clues in your official clue booklet be your guide as venture out on foot or bike and discover Mansfield's history. At each site, fun facts will be included on special posters equipped with QR codes for smart phone use. Check off information in your booklet as you go!

3/Return and enter to win!

By 4pm, return your completed clue booklets to the Museum and be entered to win prizes. The first three booklets picked with all the correct answers will win prizes!

More Facts:

- More detailed rules and simple instructions will be provided at the time of the event in the official clue booklet.
- Allow about 45 minutes -1.5 hours to complete the hunt depending on your pace and if you are walking or biking.
- Groups of up to 10 people may work together. Each may submit his or her own booklet to the prize drawing
- It is recommended at least one person in every group has a smart phone with a QR code scanner.

- Commemorative T-shirts are available for order online and help to defray the cost of the hunt.
